Dr. Gary Ing B.Sc., has been a Family Physician in the Windsor area since 1978 where he operates a thriving medical practice and has served in numerous roles at Windsor Regional Hospital, including Chief of Staff – a position which he held for 24 years up until his recent retirement.

Elected to the WFCU Credit Union Board of Directors in 2010, Dr. Ing's wealth of leadership experience has proven instrumental in the strategic guidance of the Board of Directors and WFCU Credit Union's Executive Management Team.
